1. This is a scratch event open to all 2017 TBNZ members. To be eligible for the Junior, Youth or Senior section, you must also be able to provide proof that you are under 21 years of age for Youth, under 18 years for Juniors or 49 years of age or older for Seniors as of 1 January 2017.

2. All phases of this tournament will be sanctioned and all games will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.

3. All Bowlers must bowl a minimum of 1 qualifying block of 5 games on Saturday and 1 qualifying block on Sunday.

Multiple attempts on each day are permitted.

A bowler's best attempt from each day will be combined to form a 10 game total.

All qualifying squads shall be conducted over 5 games, with a lane change following every game.

There will be a 10-minute practice for each qualifying squad.

4. Cost is \$55 for first squad each day \$40 for re- attempts. All entry fees will be non-refundable if bowler has not contacted the centre and withdrawn a minimum of 24 hours prior to bowling. If a bowler enters a qualifying squad and does not bowl – it is the bowler's responsibility to find a replacement if a waiting list is not available from the centre. Preference will be given to bowlers on the waiting list. Cost for the finals is \$25 per step you advance.

5. If you have entered and do not check in 15 minutes before your qualifying squads scheduled start time your spot maybe taken by another bowler without refund.

6. All qualifying squads must have a minimum of 8 bowlers to proceed and the tournament committee reserves the right to modify/changes bowlers and squads as required.

7. Finals shall be conducted over a best of 3 game matchplay – i.e. first to win 2 games or 1 game and the series if there is a drawn game.

8. Lane changes and draw for the finals will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director (Allison Haynes), however every effort will be made to ensure bowlers do not compete on the same pair twice.

9. Dress Code: A neat and tidy standard of dress will be required. Tailored Shorts are permitted.

10. The Tournament Committee will decide on any matters not covered within these rules. Protests must be given to the Committee within 30 minutes of the infraction. The Committee decision shall be final.

11. Prizefund is estimated at approximately \$5720 for the tournament, based on a total of 72 first attempts (\$60 prizefund each) and 25 additional attempts (\$10 prizefund each). Prizefunds will be adjusted based on entry levels in each division. A sample prize listing is below. The winner of each division also to receive a free entry into the Wellington Open 2018

Finals Format

Open Male: (Top 8)
Step 1:
Best of 3 game matchplay with 1v8, 2v7, 3v6 etc from qualifying. The four winners progress to next step
Step 2:
Best of 3 game matchplay with highest seed playing lowest seed (from qualifying), 2nd highest seed playing 2nd lowest seed etc. The 2 Winners proceed to step 3
Step 3:
The remaining 2 bowlers compete in a best of 3 game matchplay to determine the North City Open Champion

Open Female & Graded & Junior/Youth finals format (Top 6)

Step1:
Best of 3 game matchplay with 1 v 6, 2 v 4 etc from qualifying. The winners progress to next step
Step 2:
The top qualifying winner from Step 1 receives a bye into the final Step, the remaining 2 bowlers compete in a best of 3 matchplay with the winner advancing to play the top seed
Step 3:
The remaining 2 bowlers compete in a best of 3 game matchplay to determine the North City Champion for their grade.

Open Senior (Top 8)
Step 1:
Best of 3 game matchplay with 1v8, 2v7, 3v6 etc from qualifying. The four winners progress to next step
Step 2:
Best of 3 game matchplay with highest seed playing lowest seed (from qualifying), 2nd highest seed playing 2nd lowest seed etc. The 2 Winners proceed to step 3
Step 3:
The remaining 2 bowlers compete in a best of 3 game matchplay to determine the North City Open Senior Champion

Any ties during matchplay will be broken by total pinfall from 3 game series, then 9th & 10th frame roll off, then one ball sudden death as needed.
