Rules & General Information:

Eligibility: The 2017 Strike Championships are open to all current TBNZ Members.

Events: The events within the championships consist of Singles, Doubles, Mixed Doubles, Mixed Teams of 4, and Masters.

Divisions: There shall be Divisions & Grades within the Strike Championships, which include...

- Men's Open & Ladies Open Singles Any Average
- Graded Mixed Singles 165 Average & Below
- Junior Youth Singles All entrants aged under 22 as at 1st January, 2016
- Senior Mixed Singles Entrants aged 49+ years as at 1st January, 2016
- Men's Open & Ladies Open Doubles Any Average
- Mixed Graded Doubles 330 & Below
- Junior Youth Doubles All entrants aged under 22 as at 1st January, 2016
- Senior Mixed Doubles Entrants aged 49+ years as at 1st January, 2016
- Mixed Open Teams (4) Any Average
- Mixed Graded Teams (4) Combined Average of 656 & Below
- Open Mixed Doubles Any average
- Graded Mixed Doubles Combined Average of 319 & Below

Format: Singles entrants will bowl 6 games, consisting of 3 blocks of 2 games. Bowlers will change lanes after 2 games. Doubles entrants will bowl 3 games, consisting of 1 block of 3 games (without lane changes) Teams (4) entrants will bowl 3 games, consisting of 1 block of 3 games (without lane changes)

Multiple entries are accepted with the best attempt counting towards All Events.

Mixed Doubles entrants will bowl 3 games, consisting of 1 block of 3 games (without lane changes) and can be used to count towards your All Events.

Bowlers participating within the Graded Division will compete on a handicapped basis of 100% of 200

Entry Fee: A Full Entry is **\$120.00** comprising of 1xSingles entry, 1xDoubles entry and 1xTeams entry. Entries into Mixed Doubles are an additional cost of \$30.00 per bowler.

It is up to the bowlers to find themselves a team or doubles partner. The centre will help but it is not responsible to make up teams etc.

All cheques must be made payable to Strike Hutt Valley.

Individual entries into events are permitted at a cost of **\$60.00** per Singles entry, **\$30.00** per Doubles entry, and **\$30.00** per team's entry.

Masters Costs

Junior/Youth	= \$40.00
Mixed Graded – Ladies - Senior	= \$70.00
Mens Open	= \$75.00

No team or individual will be entitled to an entry refund after the entry closing date. Entries will **NOT** be accepted / confirmed without full payment, unless approved by the Tournament Director, however, fully paid entries will take precedence over non paid entries.

Masters Qualification: The following bowlers will qualify for the Masters:

- Top 6 Junior/Youth All Events, Bowling 5 games head to head - Saturday 16th September, 5.30pm
- Top 6 Senior All Events, Bowling 2 rounds of 5 games head to head - Sunday 17th September, 8.30am
- Top 10 Mixed graded All Events, Bowling 9 games head to head - Sunday 17th September, 8.30am
- Top 12 Mens All Events, Bowling 11 games head to head - Sunday 17th September, 11.30am
- Top 6 Ladies All Event, Bowling 2 rounds of 5 games head to head - Sunday 17th September, 11.30am

Graded Division will qualify with their Overall Handicapped pinfall, and their handicaps will be recalculated for the Masters event based on their scratch All Events result.

Qualifying bowlers will compete in a head to head round robin playing 1 game against each other qualifier, with bonus points awarded for an individual win (20 points) a draw (10 points each) and zero points for a loss, 5 points for a losing game over 200.

Champions: The overall Strike Champions for 2017 will be established with their All Events Qualifying Pinfall, plus their Masters Pinfall including bonus points. Graded Division will also include their handicap within this pinfall.

Playing Rules: Standard TBNZ tournament and general playing rules apply,

The Tournament Director reserves the right to close entries in whole or for any section of the tournament once a squad or the tournament is considered full. Any affected bowler will be notified prior to the entry close off date. Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Entering Averages: Your highest 2017 YTD (as at 1st August 2017) League or Tournament Average over more than 21 games must be used to enter this tournament at the time of the event. If you do not have a league average, the tournament director will grade your entry. The Tournament Director reserves the right to review all averages and re-grade if necessary.

Replacements & Substitutes: All replacements or changes in an original entry must be reported to and approved by the Tournament Director at least one hour before the scheduled bowling time. A replacement or substitute's average may lead to the team being re-graded.

Check In: Check-in must be completed by the stated times in the tournament programme. The tournament committee reserves the right to bring forward the schedule of events if all bowlers have checked in.

Warm up: Each bowler will be entitled to five minutes warm up prior to the commencement of the first game. No warm-up deliveries will be permitted prior to succeeding games or when there is a scheduled lane change or lane change due to breakdown..

Dress Standard: A general neat and tidy dress is required for participation of this tournament; entrants must not wear jeans or ripped / untidy clothing. Collared shirts or Approved Un-collared bowling shirts are required to be worn.

Ties: In the case of a tie in a singles, doubles or teams event the highest last game shall determine placing, where the placing is 1st, 2nd or 3rd

Employees: Proprietors and Employees of Strike and other Centres shall be permitted to enter.

Tournament Committee: Shall consist of the tournament director, and 2-invited representatives

Lane draw: The tournament director will make the lane draw when all entries have been received. The indicative draw will be made available by the centre before the tournament via the website at www.strikenz.co.nz

General: The use of abrasives or solvents on bowling balls or bowling shoes is not permitted during an event, except when in between blocks within an event where a lane change is made. Powder for hands must be kept in a container and must remain in the rear of the player's area. Powder is not allowed for shoes or approaches during play. Drinking and eating within the player's area is not permitted, and the consumption of alcohol, and/or smoking is not permitted while competing in an event. Failure to comply with general rules of the tournament will result in the Card Warning System,

- White Card: General warning to the participant in regards to a rules breach
- Yellow Card: Official warning to the participant in regards to a rules breach or abusive offense
- Red Card: Immediate disqualification of the participant from the tournament

The Tournament Committee reserve the right to alter the schedule of the tournament dependant on entries received. All Bowlers are required to adhere to the Dress Code and to conduct themselves in sportsmen like manner at all times.

Protests: Protests involving possible scoring errors must be lodged with the Tournament Director within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event in which the possible scoring error occurred. All other protests must be lodged in writing and signed with the Tournament Director within one hour of the conclusion of the event with which they pertain. The tournament committee will adjudicate and their decision will be final.

Matters not covered: Any matters which arise and are not covered herein will be decided by the Tournament Director.

Disclaimer: Strike Lower Hutt and staff will not be held responsible for injuries or loss of belonging's or damage to bowling equipment during the tournament; however every care will be taken to ensure the safety and enjoyment of tournament participants and their supporters.

Prize Pool, Trophies & Schedule of Events:

Prize Pool: The prize pool is Estimated at \$3000 in Cash, split amongst the Singles, Doubles, Mixed Doubles, Teams, All Events and Masters from their respective divisions and entries.
