RULES

- 1. The Bowling World Cup is a scratch event open to all 2017 Tenpin Bowling New Zealand (TBNZ)
- 2. This tournament will be played under World Bowling playing rules and regulations.
- 3. The New Zealand (NZ) representatives to the International Bowling World Cup Final must travel on a New Zealand Passport which does not expire until at least 1 June 2018. This condition must be satisfied no later than 10 September 2017. Should a representative fail to meet the above stated passport requirement by that date, they will forfeit their right to be the NZ representative in deference to the next eligible bowler from the New Zealand final.
- 4. Check in is required once at the start of each squad at reception 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the squad entered. If a bowler has not checked in by the advertised check in time, they will be replaced by the next eligible bowler in the centre.
- 5. Ties should a tie occur for any qualifying place, the bowler with the highest game will take the position. If still a tie then the highest second best game will determine the position and so on. The finals If there is a tie for first place, a head to head one game roll off will be held to determine the winner. For all other positions a tie will be declared and prize money shared accordingly.
- 6. Dress standards Men-dress trousers. Women dress trousers, tailored shorts that require a belt or skirt. All bowlers shall wear a collared shirt or a collarless shirt which is a bowling products company branded dry –fit shirt.
- 7. Protests must be in writing and given to a member of the Tournament Committee within 10 minutes of the alleged infraction occurring. Only bowlers still competing in the tournament can issue a protest.
- 8. Should there be any dispute not covered in these rules the Tournament Committee shall make a determination on the matter and their decision shall be final.
- 9. All bowlers who enter this tournament may be tested for compliance with the TBNZ Anti-Doping policy
- 10. Only participants, scorers and officials shall be allowed in the player's area.
- 11. Drinking and eating in the players area shall not be permitted
- 12. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted while competing in the event.
- Smoking will not be permitted during the playing of any part of the event.
- 14. The use of abrasives or solvents on bowling balls is only permitted at the completion of a block of games. This includes cleaning or resurfacing
- 15. Bowlers must not express or display any verbal comments of abuse of either a physical or symbolic nature towards equipment, centre staff, tournament committee, other competitors, or general public.
- 16. One yellow card may be issued as a warning for any infringement. A second occurrence will result in a red card and removal of the bowler from the tournament.

FORMAT

Lane Conditions

Different lane pattern will be used for Qualifying and Finals. The lane patterns will not be available for practice.

Qualifying - 25-26 August

Qualifying will be held at PINS over 5 game blocks. Any two 5 game blocks must be bowled to give a qualifying score. There is no re-entry.

Lanes will be reconditioned for each block.

You will move lanes after each game.

Entry fee for 2 x 5 game blocks: \$115.00 (includes TBNZ tournament fee). All fees will contribute towards Prizefund (game rate has been sponsored by Grassroots Trust)

A \$50 deposit must be paid to validate entry.

Qualifying Squad Times

(check in 15 mins prior to start time)

- 1. Friday 25 August 4.00pm (20 spots)
- 2. Friday 25 August 7.00pm (20 spots)
- 3. Saturday 26 August 12.30pm (20 spots)
- 4. Saturday 26 August 3.30pm (20 spots)
- 5. Saturday 26 August 6.30pm (20 spots)

Finals - Sunday 27 August

Men: 8.30am Start (closed check in 30 mins prior)
Top 14 men based on total pinfall from Qualifying will bowl 13 games head to head. Pinfall will be carried forward from qualifying – Cost for Mens finals \$50.00 (towards Prizefund)

Women: 1.30pm Start (closed check in 30 mins prior) Top 12 women based on total pinfall from Qualifying will bowl 11 games head to head. Pinfall will be carried forward from qualifying – Cost for Womens finals \$50.00 (towards prizefund)

Points – In matchplay, 20 points awarded for a win, 10 points for a draw. (no points for losing with a 200+ game).

Prizes

First place Male and Female will win the right to represent NZ at the QubicaAMF World Cup in Hermosillo, MEXICO. An entry VISA is required, \$2000 subsidy towards airfares and free accommodation for the tournament on a shared room basis provided by Qubica AMF. Note a one night stop over in Mexico City may be required.
