Rules and General Information

1. This is a scratch event open to all 2018 TBNZ members. To be eligible for the Junior, Youth or Senior section, you must also be able to provide proof that you are under 21 years of age for Youth, under 18 years for Juniors or 49 years of age or older for Seniors as of 1 January 2018. Girls competing in the Junior and Youth divisions will receive an 8 pin handicap per game in both the qualifying and the masters.
3. All phases of this tournament will be sanctioned and all games will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.
4. Full payment is required to secure your spot. All entry fees will be non refundable if bowler has not contacted the centre and withdrawn by the week prior. All qualifying spots booked must be paid for in full before first qualifying squad is bowled.
5. If you have entered and do not check in 15 minutes before your qualifying squads scheduled start time your spot may be taken by another bowler. TBNZ membership cards will be checked at every qualifying squad. If you do not have your membership card, you may be required to pay the Tournament registration fee. Non TBNZ members will be required to pay the Tournament registration fee.
6. Bowlers can make multiple qualifying attempts in any division they are eligible to enter in. The exception being that Juniors will only be allowed to have one (1) attempt in the Junior division. Entries in the Junior division will only be permitted in squads A, B, C, and D. When entering the tournament/squad bowlers must state what division they are qualifying for. If a bowler qualifies for more than one final, they can only bowl one final event at a time and will have to nominate which event they will participate in. Bowlers can bowl more than one final as long as they are held at different times. Bowlers must pay the full entry for the first attempt in any division.
7. Each squad must have a minimum of 9 bowlers entered 3 days before the event for the squad to run. Bowlers affected will be contacted and where available be offered spots in later squads. The tournament committee has the right to alter or amend the schedule or finalist numbers.
8. Qualifying will be over 6 games, changing lanes every two games. Each lane change shall be a 4 lane move except where the squad uses 3 or 4 pairs, then the lane change will be only 2 lanes. Men, Women, Seniors, Juniors and Youth squads will be combined. Bowlers that start on even numbered lanes will move right. Bowlers that start on odd numbered lanes will move left.
9. Qualifying squads will be based on up to 4 bowlers per pair; dependent upon entries for that squad. Bowler's starting lanes will be decided by **RANDOM** lane draw, no further correspondence will be considered after a bowler has drawn a lane.
10. Check-in for all Masters events will be a sign in (must have paid and signed in at main bowling counter prior to the close of check in). If a bowler has not paid and signed in by the advertised check in time, they will be replaced by the next eligible bowler in the centre. All Masters check-ins will close 15 minutes prior to the advertised start time.
11. Ten minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of each qualifying squad. Five minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of Masters match play.
12. Masters finalists will be Men top 12, Senior top 10, Ladies top 10, Youth top 8 and Juniors top 4 based on the highest pinfall from each bowlers "Best attempt" in the qualifying squads. Numbers in the masters may be subject to change dependent on the number of entries in qualifying.
13. Ties
 - a. Should a tie occur for the final Masters qualifying position a one game playoff will take place. If still a tie exists then a series of 9th & 10th frame playoffs will bowled until the tie is broken.
 - b. Should a tie occur for 1st place in the Masters, there will be a 1 game playoff, conducted on a pair of lanes that that masters event was conducted on. If this does not settle the tie a series of 9th & 10th frame playoffs will be bowled until a winner is decided.
 - c. For any other ties in the Masters, the prize-money will be shared.
14. Each masters event will be played in 2 person match play format. The Mens division will play 11 games, the Ladies and Seniors will play 9 games, Youth will play 7 games and the Juniors will play 6 games, (double round). Bonus points for match play will be 20 points for a win, 10 points for a draw. Qualifying will be on the short lane pattern and the masters will be played on the medium lane pattern.
15. Pinfall will not be carried over at any stage of this tournament.
16. Squad F can only be bowled in as a re-entry squad, and is only open to bowlers whom have already set a qualifying score in a previous squad in the division they intend to bowl in for squad F.
17. Dress standards.
 - a. **Men and Boys** (regardless of the division entered) will wear dress trousers and a collared shirt or a branded bowling shirt must be worn. Male bowlers will not be permitted to wear shorts.
 - b. **Women and Girls** (regardless of the division entered) dress trousers, tailored shorts or skirt, ¾ pants are allowed. No track pants, denim, cargo, are permitted. A collared shirt or a branded bowling shirt must be worn.
 - c. Dress standards will be checked at check-in times.
18. All bowlers who enter this tournament may be tested for compliance with the TBNZ Anti-Doping Policy. *Note: many drugs remain present in the body for months after use. If you are unsure about your drug free status, do NOT enter this tournament.
19. Protests are to be given verbally to a member of the tournament committee within 10 minutes of the occurring infraction and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of play of the relevant squad or final.
20. The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
