# 5. FINANCIAL REPORT (including approvals and funding applications, where required)

### **5.1. BANK BALANCES**

The total bank balance was \$39,497 as at 30 June 2016 consisting of:

These funds include \$10,996 in unused grants.

Working on allocating the draftees to teams that require players. I have brought this date forward to enable bowlers & teams enough time to finalise details.

NSTC - teams that have confirmed for this event are Manukau x2, Kapiti (men only), North City x2, Wellington, Lower Hutt x2, plus an extra Mens team. Still waiting on confirmation on whether Tauranga is entering at all.

The entry form for the Auckland Classic has been uploaded, along with lane patterns for the World Cup as well. Information on the new tournament of the Wellington Championship is now available in the TBNZ website.

On the 1st September 2016 I will be sending reminders to centres re Lane inspection for 2017. These can start on the 1st October 2016. I will not be available for any TBNZ matters from the 26th July to the 20th August. Further to my report AMF Garden City Christchurch inspection is now on hold will report when further news available.

# 12. EDUCATION OFFICER'S REPORT (Update on my meeting with TBNZ CEO 24 July 2016)

# 12.1.TBNZ Bronze Coaching Course – September 2016

- USBC Bronze Level Course confirmed 17th 18th September 2016 and the flyer and call to action has been sent out to the Coaches.
- I have now booked my flight and the Invoice sent to the TBNZ Finance Manager
- Waiting on Power Point Update to TBNZ
- Some external Information shall also be presented as discussed with the CEO it will be an addition of further information pertaining to the Bronze Course but not USBC Specific.

### 12.2.TBNZ Website: Coaches & Officials

- Now that we have completed and signed the Agreement with TBA I have agreed in full with the CEO that we adopt the same Layout and some of the wording as TBA has on their website.
- All Coaches from now on will be encouraged to keep an accounting of their coaching.
- There may be TBNZ Specific Training for Coaches and these may be rolled out at times that are appropriate and as administered by TBNZ.

### 12.3. Future New TBNZ Coaches

■ In order to grow our Sport at the grassroots level, we need to look at every avenue to encourage new Level 1 Coaches. The CEO has suggested to me the following in which I agree with, which I believe should be implemented immediately - "That the affiliated clubs be approached to work with the centre management to seek funding to have the employees of the Centre to do the Level 1 USBC Course as they are the ones who are interacting with the customers and they can be in a better position to provide assistance and promote tenpin bowling as a sport to casual bowlers."

Also It is our intention (TBNZ) to fully immerse the coaching program country wide before taking on the upgrade of the Managers Manual.

### 13. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Ian Klein has accepted the role of Tournament Co-ordinator and Assistant Webmaster. Belle, David and Pete will catch up with Ian during the NSTC weekend to discuss his role further and which areas he can start to assist Pete and David.
- Tinelle Sullings has stepped down from her volunteer role as Membership Coordinator due to personal reasons, however she advised that she will finish all the remaining membership cards to be issued and also the update of the database. The responsibilities of her role will now be under the Administration Manager (Josie).
- As a result of the first two bullet points, the TBNZ website and the emails will be updated. Belle and David to discuss all changes required and these will be forwarded to Vivid.
- There were discussions around the accounting package that we use (MYOB) and it is not anticipated that this will change, however this matter will be reviewed again at the end of year.
