This is the management team meeting and update on activities from the Auckland-based volunteers

1. WELCOME

2. FINANCE

Provisional figures show this tournament with a loss of \$638 before taking into account grant funding of \$1,138 for medals/trophies.

o NYTC

Provisional figures show this tournament with a loss of \$824 before taking into account grant funding of \$324 for medals/trophies. This is partly due to the high number of 50/100 game plaques required this year 22 at a total cost of \$1,075.

- Reporting requirements prepared for the November Board Meeting:
 - Financial Statement for end of September 2017
 - Draft budget for 2018 (with Tournaments separate)

- With Jim stepping down as Finance Manager at the end of the year, Belle and Jim agreed that the following activities will be completed to close off 2017 as part of the hand-over to the new Finance Manager:
 - Reporting for all the grants received for the financial year
 - Tidy up of the Squad Account (02 account) before end of the year
 - Complete end of year 31 December Financial Report
 - File the GST for the last period
 - Arrange the audit of accounts
- Any financial recording/payment required from January 2018 will have to be fulfilled by the new Finance Manager.

3. MEMBERSHIP

- Total number of members as at 31 Oct 2017 is 1735
 - 48% Seniors/Grand Seniors
 - o 41% Adults
 - 11% Junior/Youth
- There are still some bowlers paying membership as late as the last quarter to do one tournament.
- From an administration perspective and to align with the lane sanctioning dates, it was agreed that membership fee received from the mid-October will be membership fee up to 31 December of the following year instead of reduced amount to end of current year. This business rule will take effect from 2018.

Action agreed: Belle to present to the Board the team's proposal.

4. GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

- With Josie stepping down at the end of the year and Belle focusing on hand-over activities, Belle will advise the Board that the following activities will have to be initiated by the incoming Administration Manager and CEO:
 - Membership cards for 2018 and its administration (renewals)
 - Preparation of the Sponsor Centre Agreements (for the Board to send to the sponsor centres)
 - Confirmation of sponsorship by NZTBS for bowling balls for the NTC for the three age groups
 - Funding applications for medals/trophies for TBNZ-run events

5. TECHNICAL ADMINISTRATION

- Shorty advised that the notice reminder for the lane sanctioning for 2018 was sent out to the centres and only three responded to date: Newtown, Kapiti and Pins Lincoln.
- Shorty noted that if the centre is not sanctioned means that tournaments run in the centre cannot be ranked.

Action: Send a follow up email to the centres

- Peter Kelly and Shorty Madeley are stepping down in their role as Lane Inspectors at end of year.
- The Inspector's Course should still be run and a maximum of 10 for a weekend course. The current issue is the time and confirmation of attendees.

Action: Belle to work with Shorty on the costings, then advertise for next year. Will only proceed if we get the numbers required.

6. TOURNAMENTS

- By now the other tournaments since last reporting is complete:
 - National Senior Team Championships very good numbers with 10 men's and 9 ladies' teams
 - Junior/Youth Nationals very successful with 60 bowlers participating.
 - $\circ~$ National Youth Team Championships 8 teams and it was down to the last game to determine the winner.
- The 2018 NTC rules document has been updated and will be published in the asap so regions/centres can start their preparations for the tournament.
- Pete has gathered the dates for the centre-run events for 2018. Though some still need to be confirmed, the 2018 Tournament Calendar will be loaded to the TBNZ website as soon as possible




