Tournament Format

Stage 1- Qualifying Round

All bowlers shall bowl 12 games in two blocks of 6 games, changing lanes after each 2 game series. Bowlers must choose 1x A Block and 1x B Block squads for qualifying. The top twelve men and women will advance to Stage two

Stage 2 - Intermediate Round

The top twelve men and women will bowl a further six games to give an eighteen game total scratch pinfall, to decide the top six in each division.

Stage 3 - Top 6 Match play

The top six in each division will play a five game matchplay, the pinfall will be carried forward from qualifying for this stage. The top four advancing to Stage 4

Stage 4 - Semi and Final Matches

The semi and finals will be a one game single elimination. These matches will be played as follows, 1st v 4th and 2nd v 3rd. Pinfall will not be carried forward from game to game. All matches will be played from scratch.

These matches will be played match play style, ie: player on the left lane bowls one frame, then the player on the right lane bowls two frames, each player will continue to bowl two frames. The highest seeded player will have the choice of starting lane.

Rules and General Information

- 1 This is a scratch event open to all 2018 TBNZ members. If we can not validate your membership you will be required to pay the TBNZ membership fee.
- 2 All phases of this tournament will be sanctioned and all games will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.
- 3 Full payment is required to secure your spot. All entry fees will be non refundable if a bowler has not contacted the centre and withdrawn by the week prior.
- 4 If you have entered and do not check in 15 minutes before your qualifying squads scheduled to start time your spot may be taken by another bowler.
- 5 Each squad must have a minimum of 8 bowlers entered 3 days before the event for the squad to run. Bowlers affected will be contacted and offered spots in later squads. The tournament committee has the right to amend or alter the schedule.
- 6 Qualifying will be over 12 games bowled in two squads of six games moving every two games. There will be a 4 lane move except where a squad only uses 3 or 4 lanes. Bowlers that start on even number lanes will move right. Bowlers who start on odd numbered lanes move left.
- 7 Qualifying squads will be based on up to 4 bowlers per pair, dependent upon entries per squad. Bowlers starting lanes will be decided by RANDOM lane draw, no further correspondence will be considered after a bowler has drawn a lane.
- 8 Check in for Stages 2, 3 and 4 will be a sign in (must have paid and signed in at the main bowling centre counter prior to the close of check in). If a bowler has not paid and checked in by the advertised check in time, they will be replaced by the next eligible bowler in the centre. All check-ins will close 15 minutes prior to the advertised start time.
- 9 Ten minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of all squads.
- 10 Dress standards.
 - a. **Men** must wear dress trousers and a collared shirt or a branded bowling shirt. Male bowlers will not be permitted to wear shorts.
 - b. **Women** may wear dress trousers, tailored shorts or skirt, 3/4 pants are allowed. A collar shirt or a branded bowling shirt must be worn.
- 11 A bowler shall not consume alcohol until after the completion of their last squad for the day.
- 12 All bowlers who enter this tournament may be tested for compliance with the TBNZ Anti-Doping Policy. If you are not sure about your drug free status, do Not enter this tournament.
- 13 Protests are to be given verbally to a member of the tournament committee within 10 minutes of the occurring infraction and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of play of the relevant squad or final.
- 14 The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
