## Tournament Format

### Stage 1 – Qualifying

All Bowlers shall bowl 12 games in two blocks of 6 games, changing lanes after each 2 game block. Bowlers must complete 1x A Squad (6 games) and 1x B Squad (6 games) for qualifying. The top 12 Men and top 12 Ladies will advance to Stage 2

### Stage 2 – Intermediate Round

The top 12 Men and top 12 Ladies will bowl a further 6 games to give an 18 game total pinfall. The top 6 Men and top 6 Ladies will advance to stage 3.

### Stage 3 – Matchplay

The top 6 in each division will play a 5 game head to head matchplay, with 30 pins available for a win. Pinfall will carry through from Stage 2. The top 4 in each division will progress to the Semi Finals. Pinfall will not carry through to the Semi Finals.

### Stage 4 – Semi Finals (Fresh Condition) [5 minute practice]

The Semi-Finals will be a 1 game elimination with 1v4 and 2v3. These matches will be played in Matchplay style, with the higher seed having choice of starting lane and starting order. The player who starts the match will bowl their 10<sup>th</sup> frame last. The winners of each match will progress to the finals and the losers will play off for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> position.

### Stage 5 – Finals (Fresh Condition) [ 5 minute practice]

The winners of the Semi-Finals shall compete in a one game elimination match in matchplay style. The higher seed from the semi-finals shall have the choice of starting lane and order. The winner of the match will win the 2019 QAMF NEW ZEALAND WORLD CUP QUALIFIER and EARN THE RIGHT TO REPRESENT NEW ZEALAND AT THE 2019 QAMF WORLD CUP FINAL\*\*\* (Location & Dates TBC)

*\*\*\*Winners will be responsible for their own costs to attend the World Cup Final.*

## Rules and General information

1. This is a scratch event, open to all 2019 TBNZ Members. Bowlers must be New Zealand Passport Holders to be eligible to represent New Zealand This event is a tier 1 for TBNZ Ranking purposes and membership cards must be produced upon request.
2. All phases of this tournament will be played under standard TBNZ general playing rules with additions as per below.
3. Full payment is required to secure your spot. Entry Fees will be refundable until 7 days prior.
4. Each squad must have a minimum of 8 bowlers to proceed. If a squad is cancelled, bowlers will be contacted and reallocated to an alternative squad.
5. Qualifying squads will be upto 4 bowlers per pair. Bowlers will be randomly allocated lanes by the Tournament Director.
6. All stages of the tournament will be bowled using the World Bowling Double Jump Lane courtesy ruling – please see WorldBowling.org for more information.
7. Check in and payment for all stages will be required by the times stated above. Failure to check in by these times may result in a bowlers being replaced by the next eligible competitor.
8. Ten Minutes Warm up will be given prior to all squads, including the elimination matches.
9. Dress Standards
  - a. Men may wear dress trousers or dress shorts (requiring a belt) and collared shirt or branded Tenpin Bowling Shirt.
  - b. Women may wear dress trousers, dress shorts or skirt.  $\frac{3}{4}$  pants are not permitted. A collared shirt or branded Tenpin Bowling Shirt must also be worn.
  - c. Denim or trackpants are not permitted. Hats are not permitted.
10. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke or consume alcohol during competition until their squad has finished for the day.
11. Bowlers may be tested at any time for compliance with the TBNZ Anti-Doping Policy.
12. Slow Bowling will be monitored by the tournament committee. Bowlers will have upto 30 seconds for their ball to cross the foul line, once their lane is available.
13. A card system will be in place for the tournament, with a white card (no penalty) indicating a formal warning, a yellow card (loss of score for the frame) indicating a formal infraction and a red card (loss of score for the tournament) meaning tournament disqualification.
14. Protests must be given to a members of the tournament committee within 30 minutes of the incident. Scoring issues must be notified within 10 minutes. The tournament committee's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Outside Food and Beverages are not permitted within North City Tenpin & VR. Please refrain from bringing food and drinks inside.

A ball spinner will be available for competitors to use within the Pro Shop. Please provide your own consumables.

Estimated Prize Fund (Based on 60 Entries) is \$4500 and will be subject to change.

**Entry Costs are \$ 135 for Qualifying, \$50 for Stage 2, \$50 for Stage 3  
Stage 4 and 5 have no charge.**
