Rules and General Information

1. This is a scratch even open to all 2020 TBNZ members. To be eligible for the Junior or Youth section, you must be able to provide proof that you are under 21 years of age for Youth, under 18 years for Junior as at 1st January 2020. Girls competing in the Junior and Youth divisions will receive an 8 pin handicap per game in both the qualifying and the masters.
2. All phases of this tournament will be sanctioned and all games will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.
3. Full Payment is required to secure your spot. All entry fees will be non refundable if the bowler has not contacted the centre and withdrawn by the Friday prior. All qualifying spots booked must be paid for in full before first qualifying squad is bowled.
4. If you have entered and not checked in 30 minutes before your qualifying squads scheduled start time your spot may be taken by another bowler. TBNZ membership will be checked for every bowler that competes in the tournament. If you are not a registered member you may be required to pay the fee prior to bowling.
5. Bowlers can make multiple qualifying attempts in any division they are eligible to enter in. When entering the tournament/squad bowlers must state what division they are qualifying for.
6. Each squad must have a minimum of 9 bowlers entered 3 days before the event for the squad to run. Bowlers affected will be contacted and where available be offered spots in later squads. The tournament committee has the right to alter or amend the schedule or finalist numbers. Qualifying will be over 6 games, changing lanes every 2 games. Each lane change will be only 2 lanes. Qualifying squads will be combined, men, women, Junior & Youth all bowling at the same time.
7. Qualifying squads will be based on up to 4 bowlers per pair, dependant upon entries for that squad. Bowlers starting lanes will be decided by **RANDOM** lane draw prior to the tournament by the tournament director.
8. Check-in for all masters events will be a sign in (Must have paid and signed in at main bowling counter prior to the close of check in) If a bowler has not paid and signed in by the advertised check in time, they will be replaced by the next eligible bowler in the centre. All Masters check-ins will close 30 minutes prior to scheduled start time.
9. Ten minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of each qualifying squad. Five minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of Masters match play.
10. Masters finalists will be, Men top 12, Ladies top 8, Junior top 6, Youth top 6, based on each bowlers best attempt in qualifying.
11. Ties
 - a. Should a tie occur for the final Masters qualifying position a 1 game playoff will take place. If a tie still exists the a 9th and 10th frame roll play off will be bowled until the tie is broken.
 - b. Should a tie occur for 1st place in the Masters, there will be a 1 game playoff conducted on a pair of lanes that the masters event was conducted on. If this does not settle the tie, a 9th and 10th playoff will be bowled until the tie is broken.
 - c. For any other ties in the masters, the prize money will be shared.
12. Each masters event will be played in 2 person match play format. The Mens division will play 11 games, Ladies division will play 7 games, Junior will play 5 games and Youth will play 5 games. Bonus points for Mens, Ladies, Junior & Youth will be – 20 for a win, 10 for a draw and 0 for a loss.
13. Pinfall will not be carried over at any stage of this tournament.
14. Dress Standards - All participants are able to wear any of the following
 - a. A collared shirt or a branded bowling shirt must be worn.
 - b. Dress Trousers, Tailored Shorts, Skirts or ¾ Pants are allowed.
 - c. No track pants, denim or cargo pants are permitted.
 - d. Bowlers attire will be checked that it adheres to the advertised dress code and the bowler will not be allowed to bowl and forfeit their entry fee if not followed.
 - e. There will be NO exceptions to this rule.
15. Protests are to be given verbally to a member of the tournament committee within 10 minutes of the occurring infraction and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of play of the relevant squad or final.
16. The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final – **Committee** Steven Pelling, Ashleigh Atkinson, Ian Klein
