1. This is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered Junior and Youth bowlers. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 at 1 January 2020. Junior entrants must be under the age of 18 at 1 January 2020. **2.** This is a Grade 2 TBNZ Ranked event.

3. Bowlers may compete in two divisions, Youth and Junior. The full entry fee for both divisions entered must be paid and 1 squad must be bowled each day for each division.

4. No smoking or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur. 5. Each competitor will bowl 6 games (blocks of 2) on Sat and 6 games (in blocks of 2) on Sun. The lane draw will be random.

6. Final placing will be decided on total pinfall. If a tie occurs for 1st place in any division, a 1 game roll off will take place to determine the winner. If a tie occurs in any other placing, the prize money will be shared. 7. Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time will be disgualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament Director may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate.

8. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted. Bowlers may wear dress shorts, dress pants, skirts or skorts. Shirts must either have a collar or must be a Bowling branded shirt. 9. Entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to event. No refunds will be made within 7 days prior to the tournament.

1. The Pins Junior Graded Challenge is open to all junior league bowlers. 2. This is a handicapped tournament based on 100% of 200, consisting of 4 games and a step ladder final. The entering handicap will remain unchanged for the entire tournament

3. Bowler must be 18 years or under on day of tournament.

4. Handicaps will be taken from a bowler's highest league average as at week ending Sunday 9th August 2020 5. Handicap must be based on at-least 6 games of League Play.

6. If not a Pins league bowler, attached to entry or emailed must be a standing sheet or Bowler Record Card, stating number of games bowled and current average. If a bowler bowls in more than one league, all leagues must be attached.

7. The top 5 based on total h/cap pinfall will qualify for the stepladder finals. 8. In the step ladder semi-final the 2nd highest qualifier will play the 5th and the third highest plays the 4th. The winners of those two matches will meet the 1st placed gualifier in a one game play off to determine the first three placings. Fourth place overall will be the semi-final loser with highest pinfall. 9. Standard of dress must be tidy. T-shirts with crude comments will not be accepted. Pants with rips/holes will also not be accepted.

10. This is NOT a TBNZ Ranked event.

Throughout the events,

protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director, whose decision will be final.
