## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

The Tauranga Classic is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players.

The \$125 qualifying cost includes the \$5 TBNZ tournament fee

No smoking or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.

Each competitor will bowl 8 games (4 blocks of 2) on Saturday moving 2 pairs for qualifying.

### **Pinfall carries forward into masters.**

Entry fee is \$125, which compromises of \$96 lane fees, \$5 TBNZ fee and \$79 prize fund. Prize payout will be based on 1 in 3 pay-out and posted when final No's have confirmed.

The lane pattern used for Qualifying will be PBA Dragon

The lane pattern used for Masters will be PBA Viper

Final place will be decided on total pinfall over both days. Should a tie occur for 1st place, a one game roll off will decide the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placing the prize money will be split.

Any bowler who fails to meet the check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any moneys paid. The tournament committee may permit a late entry, the used of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the TD deems appropriate.

All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This includes either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts that require a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers or shorts. Track pants, cargo pants or any denim material are not permitted.

All entry fees will be refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.

Protest are to be given verbally to the tournament committee within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the tournament committee, whose decision will be final.
