- The Tauranga Classic is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior competitors must be ages 50 or older as of 31/12/22
- No smoking, vaping or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.
- Ball maintenance is to only be done prior to or after completion of your squad. No equipment maintenance is to be done during qualifying or masters play.
- Each competitor will bowl 8 games (4 blocks of 2) in qualifying moving I or 2 pairs depending on entry numbers. No multiple entries but you can enter multiple divisions
- Masters will be matchplay format, I3
 games for men and 9 games for
 women/Senior
- <u>Pinfall carries forward into masters.</u>
- Entry fee is \$125, which compromises of \$64 lane fees, \$5 TBNZ fee and \$56 prize fund. Prize payout will be based on I in 3 payout and posted when final No's are confirmed.
- Lane pattern for qualifying will be 'Tauranga Classic Medium'
- Lane pattern for masters will be 'Tauranga Classic Long'

TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS

- Any bowler who fails to meet the checkin time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any moneys paid. The tournament committee may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the TD deems appropriate.
- Final place will be decided on total pinfall over both days. Should a tie occur for 1st place, a one game roll off will decide the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placing the prize money will be split.
- All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This includes either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts that require a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers or shorts. Track pants, cargo pants or any denim material are not permitted.
- All entry fees will be refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.
- Protest are to be given verbally to the tournament directors within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.
- Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the tournament committee, whose decision will be final.
