## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

The Waitakere Masters is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior Men and Senior Women entrants must attain the age of 50 or above in 2022. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022.

Bowlers may compete in more than one division as long as round 2 doesn't clash.  
Only one attempt per division is allowed.

The Youth Division will include an 8 pin handicap per game for all Youth Women competing.

No smoking or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.

Each competitor will bowl 8 games (in blocks of 2) in Round 1. The top 16 Senior Men, 8 Senior Women, 20 Open Men, 8 Open Women and 20 Youth will continue on to bowl 8 games (in blocks of 2) in Round 2 on Sunday. Round 1 lane draw will be random. Round 2 Youth & Senior Men will be separated, Open Women & Senior Women will bowl together and Open Men will be separated from the women. Round 2 lane draw will be based on round 1 finishing positions at Tournament Directors discretion.

10 Minutes practice will commence 5 minutes after the advertised check in time.

Ties – should a tie occur for any Round 1 position, the positions shall be determined by highest game in Round 1. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on.

Final placing will be decided on total pinfall after 16 games. Should a tie occur for 1<sup>st</sup> place, a one game playoff will decide the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placing the prize money will be split.

Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament Director may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate.

All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers, or dress shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted.

**New Ball drilling and ball surface rules:**

- a) Balls without a thumbhole must have a scribed or engraved cross-hair lines (+) near the centre of the palm to indicate the grip orientation. The ball must be delivered in the marked orientation (i.e. palm must cover the "+").**
- b) No ball surface can be altered after the last ball in practice is bowled until the last ball is bowled in an 8 game squad.**

The tournament director may conduct a random ball check at any time.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director, whose decision will be final.
