TOURNAMENT RULES

The Bay of Plenty Open is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior Men and Senior Women entrants must attain the age of 50 or above in 2023. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 prior to the 1st January 2023.

Bowlers may compete in more than one division if the Matchplay Finals do not clash.

The Youth Division will include an 8 pin handicap per game for all females competing.

Qualifying Pattern: Stonehenge. Masters Pattern: Big Ben

The consumption of alcohol is not permitted while competing or if you still have events left to complete for the day. Smoking/Vaping is not permitted while competing in any event.

6 GAME QUALIFYING: Each competitor will bowl 2 x 3 game qualifying squads. Multiple attempts allowed with the 2 highest 3 game squads. Games will be bowled four to a pair. All 3 games will be bowled on the one pair, no lane changes. This may be changed by the tournament committee depending on squad No's. Junior Boys & Junior Girls final placings will be determined by qualifying scores.

Junior Boys & Junior Girls divisions only play 6 games which does not make them eligible to earn grade 2 ranking points. Junior Boys & Junior girls will receive ranking points for a grade 3 event.

MATCHPLAY FINALS: The top 10 senior Men, Top 12 Men, Top 8 Senior Women, Top 8 Open Women & Top 12 Youth will move through to the Matchplay finals. Matchplay will consist of one head to head match against all other finalists in their division. Pinfall will not be carried from Qualifying to Matchplay final. (Junior finals will be bowled 2 per lane).

All Matchplay finals will include pinfall and bonus points. Bonus points are 30 for a win and 15 for a draw.

5 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all qualifying squads.

5 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all Matchplay finals.

TIES

QUALIFYING: Should a tie occur for any position, placing shall be determined by highest qualifying game. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on.

MATCHPLAY: Should a tie occur in any Matchplay position other than to determine 1st place, the highest scratch Pin fall will determine final placings. Should a tie occur in 1st place, a 9th / 10th frame roll off will determine 1st place until the tie is broken.

Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament Director may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate.

All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men may wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers, or dress shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted.

Ball surface adjustments are not permitted until the end of a SQUAD. Not Permitted between blocks. See TBNZ Playing rules for more info.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Director with 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters no covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director, whose decision will be final.
