- This Tournament is a scratch event. Entry is open to all current TBNZ registered players, who must attain the age of 50 or above in the year of this competition. Proof of age is required if the entrant has not previously bowled as a senior in a TBNZ certified tournament.
- This tournament will be TBNZ certified and all games will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.
- No smoking this include vaping or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of the competitors squad. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.
- There is a separate division for men and women, with a prize pool that is paid out according to the entries in each division. All money will be bank transferred
- This tournament is a Grade two TBNZ ranked event.
- Their will be 2 Saturday squads which will have a maximum of 24 bowlers in each squad. On Sunday bowlers will swap squad times and bowl their second 8 game squad.
- Each bowler may only bowl in one squad, no reattempts.
- Each competitor will bowl 8 games (in 4 blocks of 2) on Saturday and 8 games (in 4 blocks of 2) on Sunday. The number of lanes moved after each block will be determined by the tournament director, with the intent of trying (as far as is practicable) to ensure that each bowler experiences similar use of the lanes in play.
- All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. NO refunds will be made within the 7 days prior to the tournament.

- Each day a different lane pattern will be used. And pinfall will carry forward.
- Placing will be decided on total pinfall. Should a tie occur for 1st place, a one game playoff will decide the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placing, the prize money will be split.
- ENTRY FEE is \$200, which comprises \$96 lane fees, \$5 TBNZ tournament fee and \$99 prize fund. Prize payout will be based on one in three payout and posted one week prior to tournament commencement date.
- Any bowler who fails to meet either check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The tournament Director may permit a late entry from a new competitor, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate. Seven minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of each day of bowling.
- All competitors will be required to be suitably attired, with a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a short sleeved collared bowling shirt or a branded bowling shirt. Males must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women must wear skirts, dress trousers, or shorts of any length. Track pants, cargo pants, stirrup pants, or any denim material are not permitted.
- A deposit of \$50 is required upon entry. The balance of \$150 can be paid at any time before the Saturday check-in. Entries after this close off date will only be accepted if the centre manager decides this assists with the centre's allocation of lanes. The centre manager's decision in this respect is final so please ensure you have paid your deposit by the required time.
- Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the tournament director, whose decision will be final.
