- The Tauranga Classic is a scratch & Graded event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior competitors must be ages 50 or older as of 31/12/23
- For Graded and Junior the handicaps will be worked out on a 90% of 200 base.
- No smoking, vaping or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.
- Ball maintenance is to only be done prior to or after completion of your squad. No equipment maintenance is to be done during qualifying or masters play.
- Each competitor will bowl 8 games qualifying in 2 squads of 4 games. Multiple attempts are allowed and your highest 2 squads of 4 games will be used for qualifying position.
- Bowlers are permitted to bowl in multiple divisions.
- Masters will be match play format. 11 games for open, 9 games for Senior Men, 10 games for Womens & 7 games for Senior Womens. Womens is a double round matchplay. Juniors & Graded have no masters, placings are based off the 8 game qualifying scores.
- In match play competitors will receive 20 Bonus pins for a win, 10 for a draw
- **Pinfall does not carry forward to masters**
- 2 oil patterns will be used. 1 for qualifying and 1 for masters.
- Any bowler who fails to meet the check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any moneys paid. The tournament committee may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the TD deems appropriate.
- Should a tie occur for 1st place, a one game roll off will decide the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placing the prize money will be split. Tie for final qualifying spot will be decided by the highest qualifying block.
- All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This includes either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men may wear dress trousers or tailored shorts that require a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers or shorts. Track pants, cargo pants or any denim material are not permitted.
- All entry fees will be refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.
- Protest are to be given verbally to the tournament directors within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.
- Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the tournament committee, whose decision will be final.
