# **TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This Tournament is a scratch event. Entry is open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior bowlers must attain the age of 50 years in the year of competition. Grand Senior bowlers must attain the age of 65 or above in the year of the competition.

No smoking/vaping or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.

There is a separate division for senior men and senior women, Grand Senior Men and Grand Senior Women, with a prize pool that is paid out according to the entries in each division. A bowler can only enter 1 division.

This is a Grade 2 TBNZ Senior event. Grand Senior Divisions will not be ranked due to the added handicap.

Grand Seniors will receive a one (1) pin handicap for every year of age above the age of 65. e.g. a bowler aged 66 will receive a one (1) pin handicap for every game bowled in the Grand Senior division. A bowler aged 70 will receive a five (5) pin handicap for every game bowled in the Grand Senior division.

There will be two squads each day which will have a maximum of 32 bowlers in each. There will be a maximum of 4 bowlers per pair of lanes.

Each athlete will bowl 8 games (in blocks of 2) on Saturday and 8 games (in blocks of 2) on Sunday. A lane draw will be done to try to ensure that (as far as is practicable) females do not bowl on the same lane. The number of lanes moved after each block will be determined by the Tournament Director, with the intent of trying (as far as is practicable) to ensure that each bowler experiences similar use of the lanes in play.

Placing will be decided on total pinfall. Should a tie occur for 1<sup>st</sup> place, the winner will be determined by the highest 2 game block in round 1 and 2 combined (4 games). If a tie still occurs, the highest game will determine the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placing, the prize money will be split.

ENTRY FEE is \$210, which comprises \$115 lane fees, \$5 TBNZ tournament fee and \$90 prize fund.

Any bowler who fails to meet either check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament Director may permit a late entry from a new competitor, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate. Ten minutes practice will be given at the advertised start time of each squad. Each squad will be played on a fresh lane condition.

All competitors are required to be suitably attired, with a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared bowling shirt or a bowling branded shirt. Men must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women must wear skirts, dress trousers, or shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted. Anyone not meeting the dress standard required will not be permitted to bowl.

A deposit of \$50 is required no later than 7 days prior to event to secure a place.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within the 7 days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director, whose decision will be final.
