Rules and General Information

- 1 The **Tamariki Cup** is a grade 2 event open to all current TBNZ & TBA registered players.
Youth under the age of 21 as of 1st January 2024.
Junior under the age of 18 as of 1st January 2024.
- 2 **Divisions: Youth Men, Youth Women, Junior Boys, Junior Girls, Graded - No Multi Attempts.**
- 3 Bowlers may compete in more than one division but no more than two per person.
- 4 Each squad will consist of 6 games, 3 squads on Saturday and 2 squads on Sunday.
- 5 Qualifying is 12 Games, Each competitor will bowl 2x 6 game blocks bowled over the 2 days.
- 6 The Competitor must compete in one squad per day, per division that the athlete is bowling.
- 7 Squads will be run with 3 to a Pair and lane changes after every 2 games odds & evens.
- 8 Step Ladder Finals are worked out from the top 5 from each division after the qualifying
Step Ladder is head to head matches, The winner moving forward 5v4, Wv3, Wv2, Wv1
TOP SEED PLAYERS OF EACH DIVISION PICKS THE PATTERN FOR THE STEP LADDER FINAL
- 9 10 minutes practice will commence at the advertised start time for all qualifying squads.
5 minutes practice will commence at the advertised start time for the first stepladder.
Warm up lanes will be on for the next seeded player to use once the match has started.
- 10 **TIES:**
All Qualifying ties will be decided on the highest 6 game series block from the 12 games.
All Stepladder ties will be decided on a 9th & 10th frame roll off, if the tie still has not
been broken then a shot by shot roll off will continue until a winner is decided.
- 11 Ball surface adjustments are not permitted from the end of practice to the end of 6 games.
Ball surface adjustments can be made during any practice session during the weekend.
- 12 No powder to be used on shoes/bowling balls or in bowlers area during competition.
- 13 Full payment is required to secure your spots. All entry fees are non refundable if the bowler
has not contacted the centre and withdrawn from the squads 7 days prior to competition.
- 14 If you do not check in 15 mins before your advertised start time you will be disqualified,
without refund. Use of pacers/Reallocation of the bowlers is appropriate by the Committee.
- 15 Dress Standard must be clean and tidy and According to TBNZ rules per Gender.
- 16 Protest are to be given verbally to a member of the Tournament Committee within 10 mins
of the occurring infringement & confirmed in writing within 10 mins of completion of play.
- 17 The Consumption of alcohol is not permitted while competing or if you still have events left
to compete in for the duration of that day of competition.
- 18 Smoking/Vaping is not permitted while competing in any event series.
- 19 Bowlers who enter our tournament will automatically agree to our rules listed above.
Any matters arise and are not covered here shall be decided by Tournament Committee.
- 20 Prize money is guaranteed but will increase dependant on entries this is based on 30 entries.
