## TOURNAMENT RULES

The Waitakere Open is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior Men and Senior Women entrants must attain the age of 50 or above in 2024. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024.

Bowlers may compete in more than one division as long as Matchplay Final doesn't clash.

The Youth Division will include an 8 pin handicap per game for all females competing.

Qualifying Pattern: 39 foot – 2022 PWBA Rockford Open. Finals Pattern: 44 Foot – 2021 IBF Super worlds - Dubai

The consumption of alcohol is not permitted while competing or if you still have events left to complete for the day.  
Smoking/Vaping is not permitted while competing in any event.

8 GAME QUALIFYING: Each competitor will bowl 2 x 4 game qualifying squads. Multiple attempts allowed with the 2 highest 4 game squads being used.

MATCHPLAY FINALS: The top 10 Senior Men, 10 Senior Women, 10 Open Women, 12 Youth, 4 Junior Boys and 4 Junior Girls will move through to the Matchplay finals. Matchplay will consist 1 head to head match against all other finalists in their division. Pinfall will not be carried from Qualifying to Matchplay final. (Junior finals will be bowled 2 per lane)

The top 16 Open Men will split into 2 groups of 8 for a Semi final. The 2 pools will be determined by placings as follows:

Pool One: 1,4,5,8,9,12,13,16 Pool Two: 2,3,6,7,10,11,14,15

Semi Finals will be bowled in a Matchplay of 7 head to head games.

All Matchplay finals will include pinfall and bonus points. Bonus points are 30 for a win and 15 for a draw.

STEPLADDER FINALS (**Open Men only**): The top 2 from each pool will compete in a Stepladder Final. (FRESH OIL)

Stepladder position will be determined by Matchplay pinfall inc. bonus points. Seeds 2, 3 and 4 will bowl 1 game head to head with the winner advancing to the final game against the top seed. Final game will be bowled on a fresh pair.

3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place will be determined by the highest game in Stepladder.

5<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> place will be determined by total pinfall in Matchplay final NOT including bonus points. (high game will break all ties)

7 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all qualifying squads.

7 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all Matchplay finals.

TIES:

QUALIFYING: should a tie occur for any position, placing shall be determined by highest qualifying game. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on.

MATCHPLAY: Should a tie occur in any Matchplay position other than to determine 1<sup>st</sup> place, the highest scratch Pin fall will determine final placings. Should a tie occur in 1<sup>st</sup> place, a 9<sup>th</sup> / 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off will determine 1<sup>st</sup> place until the tie is broken.

STEPLADDER: Should a tie occur in any placing in the Stepladder final, a 9<sup>th</sup> / 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off will determine the win until the tie is broken.

Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament Director may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate.

All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men may wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers, or dress shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted.

Ball Surface adjustments not permitted until the end of a SQUAD. Not permitted between blocks. See TBNZ Playing rules for more info.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director, whose decision will be final.
