**TOURNAMENT RULES**

The Tauranga Classic is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior Men and Senior Women entrants must attain the age of 50 or above in 2025. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025. Junior entrants must be under the age of 18 prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2025.

Bowlers may compete in more than one division if the Matchplay Finals do not clash.

Qualifying Pattern: 2023 SYC Rhode Long - Masters Pattern: 2007 Weber Cup Day 2

The consumption of alcohol is not permitted while competing or if you still have events left to complete for the day. Smoking/Vaping is not permitted while competing in any event.

6 GAME QUALIFYING: Each competitor will bowl 1 x 6 game qualifying squad. Multiple attempts allowed. Games will be bowled four to a pair. Lane changes every 2 games. Check in is 10 minutes prior to the advertised start time of each squad. **Junior Boys & Junior Girls final placings will be determined by qualifying scores and will be ranked as a GRADE 3.**

If a squad is no longer required by a bowler a waiting list will be provided where bowlers seeking to buy/sell squads are able to do so. Arrangement of payment is to be made between the two bowlers.

MATCHPLAY FINALS: The top 12 senior Men, Top 12 Men, Top 8 Senior Women, Top 8 Open Women, Top 10 Youth Men & Top 8 Youth Women will move through to the Matchplay finals. Matchplay will consist of one head-to-head match against all other finalists in their division. Pinfall will not be carried forward from Qualifying to Matchplay final. Check in is 15 minutes prior to the advertised start time of each Matchplay finals

All Matchplay finals will include pinfall and bonus points. Bonus points are 20 for a win and 10 for a draw.

5 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all qualifying squads & 5 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all Matchplay finals.

TIES:  
QUALIFYING: Should a tie occur for final masters qualifying position, placing shall be determined by highest 2 game qualifying block. If still tied highest individual game will determine placings.

MATCHPLAY: Should a tie occur in any Matchplay position other than to determine 1<sup>st</sup> place, the highest scratch Pin fall will determine final placings. Should a tie occur in 1<sup>st</sup> place, a 9<sup>th</sup> / 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off will determine 1<sup>st</sup> place until the tie is broken.

Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament committee may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament committee deems appropriate.

All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men may wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers, or dress shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted.

Ball surface adjustments are permitted between blocks of games (Lane changes) See TBNZ Playing rules for more info.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament. During the duration of the tournament the tournament committee have no responsibility for the sale of squads you no longer require, the competitor is required to make their own arrangements and inform the committee of the replacement.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament committee with 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters no covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament committee, whose decision will be final.
