



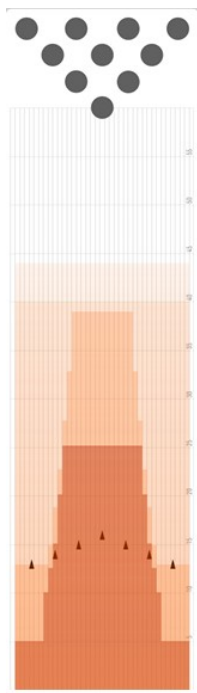

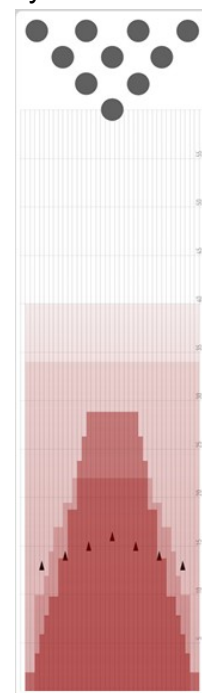

General Rules

1. The Auckland Classic is a scratch event open to all 2026 TBNZ members.
2. This is a TBNZ certified event, all phases of this tournament will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.
3. There will be a separate Men's and Women's divisions.
4. Qualifying shall be 8 games moving every two games one pair left and right. One attempt only permitted for each division entered. If entry numbers permit, there will be 3 per pair in squad 1. 4 per pair in squad 2/3.
5. 7 minute practice for Qualifying and 7 minutes practice for Finals.
6. The top 14 men and top 14 women shall advance to their respective Matchplay finals.
7. Ties – should a tie occur in qualifying or finals, the position shall be determined by highest game in that section of play i.e qualifying for qualifying, Finals for Finals. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on. There will be no play-offs.
8. All Finals will be a head to head match play with 20 points awarded for a win and 10 points for a draw.
9. Pinfall from the qualifying section will be carried forward to Finals.
10. Finals will be a check in at reception. If a bowler has not checked in before the stated check in time, the next highest qualified reserve present will be invited to compete.
11. Dress standards for all sections of this tournament are as follows.
 - Men – dress trousers, tailored shorts, and collared shirt or approved bowling branded shirt e.g. Storm, Hammer etc.
 - Ladies – dress trousers, $\frac{3}{4}$ pants, tailored shorts or skirt and collared shirt or approved bowling branded shirt per above
 - No denim, no track pants, no cargo trousers or cargo shorts.
12. **Anyone not meeting the dress standard required will not be permitted to bowl. If in Qualifying the deposit will be forfeited.**
13. Any protests are to be made verbally to a member of the tournament committee within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing. All disputes will be dealt with by the Committee and all decision shall be final.
14. Bowlers who enter this tournament are deemed to have read and agreed to the rules listed above.
