

This Tournament is a scratch event. Grade 2.

Entry is open to all current TBNZ registered players.

This tournament will be TBNZ certified, and all games will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.

U21 bowlers must be under the age of 21 Prior to the 1st of January 2026 and U18 bowlers must be under the age of 18 Prior to 1st January 2026.

Proof of age is required if the entrant has not previously bowled as a U18 or U21 in a TBNZ certified tournament."

Each competitor will bowl 9 games to qualify. Bowled in squads of 3 games per squad. Best 3 squads to make the 9 games total. Multiple entries are permitted.

The Top 6 bowlers in each Division will compete in the masters. 5 games head-to-head - 20 bonus points for a win, 10 for a draw. Pinfall is not carried over from qualifying.

Placing will be decided on total pinfall. In the event of a tie for the final qualifying spot, the bowler with the highest single-game qualifying score within their best 3 squads will advance. Should this result in another tie, the next highest games shall be compared.

ENTRY FEE is \$150 for 3 squads. Any bowler who fails to meet either check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The tournament Committee may permit a late entry from a new competitor, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Committee deems appropriate.

7 minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of each day of bowling.

All competitors will be required to be suitably attired, with a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a short sleeved collared bowling shirt or a branded bowling shirt.

Males must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt.

Women may wear skirts, dress trousers, dress 3/4 pants or dress shorts.

A deposit of \$50 is required no later than 7 days prior to event to secure a place. The balance can be paid at any time before the bowlers check-in. All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within the 7 days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Committee within 10 minutes of the occurring infraction and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the days' play. Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision will be final.

No smoking/vaping or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play for the bowler on each day.
