TOURNAMENT RULES

The Waitakere Junior and Youth Cup is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered Junior and Youth bowlers. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 prior to 1 January 2026. Junior entrants must be under the age of 18 prior to 1 January 2026.

Junior Graded Entries shall use their current TBNZ tournament average obtained from the TBNZ Rankings page as at 1 March 2026. The average used must be established over a minimum of 12 games. If a bowler ranked average does not fit this criteria, their highest league average based over a minimum of 12 games must be used. If a bowler cannot provide proof of any average they must compete in the relevant Open division.

Junior Boys holding an average of 160 or higher must enter the Junior Boys Open division.

Junior Girls holding an average of 150 or higher must enter the Junior Girls Open division.

Handicaps for the Junior Graded Division will be based on 90% of 200

This is a Grade 2 TBNZ Ranked event. (Graded division will not be ranked)

Bowlers may compete in all 3 divisions as long as they fit criteria. The full entry fee for all divisions entered must be paid and 1 squad must be bowled each round for each division. (Graded only round 1)

If there are less than 6 athletes in any 1 division, the tournament committee may combine divisions. If a male and female division is combined, females will receive 8 pin handicap per game. Where there is a combined division, the prizefund will be adjusted accordingly. The tournament committee's decisions on combining divisions is final.

There will be a lane condition prior to every squad.

No smoking, vaping or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.

Each competitor will bowl 6 games (in blocks of 2) in Round one and 6 games (in blocks of 2) on in Round two. The lane draw will be random. (Junior Graded Division will only bowl 6 games total – completed in Round One only)

7 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised start time of each squad.

Final placing will be decided on total pinfall. If a tie occurs for 1st place in any division, a 1 game roll off will take place to determine the winner. If a tie occurs in any other placing, Highest game will break the tie.

Shoe Fresh STEPLADDER FINAL: Will not be ranked. Girls will not have a handicap (unless the division had been combined). Stepladder final will be bowled on the burn of squad E – No Re-oil. If divisions are combined due to lack of entries, the stepladder final format may be altered to suit.

If there is a 1st place draw in the semi final (2nd, 3rd and 4th place) a 9/10th frame play off will decide who plays the number 1 seed.

Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time (15 mins prior to advertised start time) as per the centre clock may be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament committee may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament committee deems appropriate.

All athletes are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men may wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers, or dress shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 3 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within three days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament committee within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament committee, whose decision will be final.

This is a TBNZ ranked event so entrants will receive ranking points based on their 12 game finishing position
