## TOURNAMENT RULES

The Waitakere Open is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior Men and Senior Women entrants must attain the age of 50 or above in 2026. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026. Junior entrants must be under the age of 18 prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026.

Bowlers may compete in more than one division.

Qualifying Pattern: 42 Foot – 2024 PBA ROTH. Finals Pattern: 46 Foot – 2024 PBA PETRAGLIA

The consumption of alcohol is not permitted while competing or if you still have events left to complete for the day.

Smoking/Vaping is not permitted while competing in any event.

8 GAME QUALIFYING: Each athlete will bowl 2 x 4 game qualifying squads. Multiple attempts allowed with the 2 highest 4 game squads being used.

JUNIOR DIVISION: No matchplay final. 8 games of qualifying will determine final placings for both Boys & Girls division. – No multiple attempts

MATCHPLAY FINALS: The top 12 Open Men, 10 Open Women, 12 Senior Men, 10 Senior Women, 12 Youth Men and 6 Youth Women will move through to the Matchplay finals. Matchplay will consist 1 head to head match against all other finalists in their division. Pinfall will not be carried from Qualifying to Matchplay final.

All Matchplay finals will include pinfall and bonus points. Bonus points are 30 for a win and 15 for a draw.

7 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all qualifying squads.

7 Minutes practice will commence at the advertised time for all Matchplay finals.

### TIES:

QUALIFYING: should a tie occur for any position, placing shall be determined by highest qualifying game. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on.

MATCHPLAY: Should a tie occur in any Matchplay position other than to determine 1<sup>st</sup> place, the highest scratch Pin fall will determine final placings. If the tie remains unbroken, the highest scratch game will determine final placings. Should a tie occur in 1<sup>st</sup> place, a 9<sup>th</sup> / 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off will determine 1<sup>st</sup> place until the tie is broken.

In any Qualifying squad, any bowler who fails to meet check-in time may be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament Committee may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate. In any Matchplay final, if a finalist fails to meet check-in time, they will be disqualified and the next available reserve will be invited to compete.

All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men may wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women may wear skirts, dress trousers, or dress shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament committee within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament committee, whose decision will be final.
